A note on wooden chicken housing

Wood is a natural living product and as such there will be surface irregularities and even knots. Wood will expand and contract according to the weather and our structures are designed to be flexible enough to allow this natural process. In particular the floors on our chicken coops are designed to allow ventilation, and there will be gaps in the corners for this purpose.

You will need the following tools

- screwdriver / powerdrill
- hammer

delivered with the chicken coop:

- 12 x gold electroplated nails (1 reserve) (A)
- 4 (6) x nails – 2,4 x 40 (B)
- screws: - 4; 3 x 25 (C)
 - 13; 3,5 x 40 (D)
 - 16; 4,5 x 60 (E)

Main chicken coop

- Screw one of the side panels to the front panels using screw (E). The side panel has to be attached to the front panel from behind and the screws will need to be screwed from the inside through the frame of the side panel into the front panel.
- Then attach the other side panel the same way to the front panel.
- Attach the back panel to the side panels (making up the 4-sided chicken coop) by screwing the screws from the inside through the frame of the side panels into the back panel.
- Slip in the green chipboard floor so it lies on the bars and nail it to the bars using nails (D).
- Attach the 4 aluminium strips to the side corners of the chicken coop with nails (A) (Check that the shorter aluminium strips are attached to the back of the chicken coop and the longer ones to the front)
- Attach the door to the front of the panel using the two hinges and screws (C).
- Fit the two perches inside the chicken coop with screw (D) (spaced out at your discretion).



Nesting box

- Attach the two side panels (no 1 & 2) from the side to the middle panel (no 3) by screwing screws (E) through the middle panel into the side panels.
- Slip in the nesting box floor (with the wooden compartment dividers facing up) so it lies on the bars and nail it to the bars using nails (D).
- Attach the two small aluminium strips to the corners of the nesting box with nails (A).
- Slide the complete nesting box into the main chicken coop by the opening provided. Attach the nesting box from the inside to the main chicken coop with screws (E).
- Attach the wooden bar with the nesting lid to the side of the main chicken coop so it covers the nesting box with 3 x screws (D).
- Close the main chicken coop with the lid so that the aluminium-striped side faces the front (this enables the water to drain at the back).
